

Helsinki - Nastola



From both airport and harbor you follow the signs to highway 4 and Lahti. Although Google shows it as E75 the signs on the road have a red square with a white 4 on it. Once you are on the highway it's pretty easy. You will pass places like Kerava, Järvenpää (the birth town of Sibelius), Mäntsälä (most remarkable for its yellow Shell station on the highway) and Orimattila until you reach Lahti. Watch out, there are a couple of exits for Lahti. Make sure to take the one that says: Kouvola, Nastola and Lahti I. On the exit ramp keep to the left and follow the signs towards Kouvola. This should get you on road no. 12, a wide lane road. After about 10 – 12km you see the exit sign Nastola. Take this exit and follow its long left bend until it hits a t-junction next to an ABC gas station. There you turn right and follow the road until you come to a traffic light after another 800m. Continue straight ahead at the traffic lights and drive into the small town. After another km or so you see the yellow wooden church on your left hand side. That's where the wedding ceremony will take place. At the next larger crossing you turn left. If you're heading towards the Lodging location, the Pajulahti Sports Center, you go straight another 3km. If you are directly on your way to the wedding, you follow the signs to the "Taidekeskus Taarasti" (= Art center Taarasti)
